APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Fill out this application form in consultation with your high school counsellor or other school official. Programs and courses available to Transitions students are listed below.
- All first-time applicants are required to remit a \$35 non-refundable application processing fee (\$100 for International applicants). If you have paid this fee before, it is not necessary to pay it again; however, applications will only be reviewed if there is evidence of this payment.
- Applicants must submit interim high school transcripts before they will be accepted into any program or course delivered by Selkirk College, including individual distance courses. All transcripts and other documents become the property of Selkirk College and will not be returned to the student.
- Applicants for full-time programs are required to take the *Computerized Placement Test (CPT)*, a basic skills assessment of reading and math. Call a Selkirk College campus to arrange a time to complete this assessment, or inquire about writing the CPT at your high school.
- Submit your completed application form, high school transcript, AND the non-refundable \$35 application fee (\$100 for International students) to Selkirk College Admissions, as indicated below.
