INSTRUCTIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Apply to attend Selkirk College as a full-time (minimum 80% course load) post-secondary student for the fall 2010 semester.
2. Students currently attending High School should complete and submit this application to the school's counselling office. Please check with your counsellor regarding your school's application deadline.

The High School Counsellor is asked to verify the students' grades by initialling beside each grade reported, acknowledging whether this is an interim or final grade, and submitting this application directly to Financial Aid Office at Selkirk College.

Applications received by Selkirk College that arrive directly from a student and not the high school will not be accepted unless the student is not currently attending the high school (i.e., graduated prior to this year). In that case, students must submit an official, sealed transcript from their high school with this application.

3. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. Selection will be based on all Grade 12 grades. Grade 11 grades will be considered where appropriate.
5. **All applications must be received in the Financial Aid Office of Selkirk College by Friday, April 9, 2010.**
6. Selkirk College reserves the right to withhold any award for which no funds have been received or no applicant is deemed suitable.
