

International Tuition Fees

All fees are due and payable on or before the first day of class. You can refer to our [important dates](#) for these dates.

Students are charged per semester for the courses they are registered in. Each semester students will register/be registered in the next semester courses and a new tuition charge will be placed on the students accounts.

Your payment options are as follows:

- **PAYMENTS THROUGH STUDENT RECORD:** Pay online with a credit card from your student record account. [Access your student record](#). Select “Fees” to review the outstanding balance on the account and to make a payment.
- **ONLINE BANK PAYMENT:** Pay online through your financial institution. Set up Selkirk College as a vendor on your account, use your 6 digit student number as the account number.
- **PAY IN PERSON:** Pay in person at any of our campuses with cash, cheque, money order, bank draft, debit or credit card. Cheques, money orders and bank drafts are to be addressed to Selkirk College and show your student number clearly on the front.
