



How do I apply for a student loan?

Follow these next steps.

STEP 1: CLICK LOGIN / REGISTER TO APPLY

STEP 2: CREATE YOUR PROFILE

- If you have never applied for a BC Student Loan, click here to set up your profile.
- You will need your Social Insurance Number to do this.

If you have already had your Services BC card verified, click here to log in using your Mobile Card or the USB

STEP 3: GET ID VERIFIED

Once you have created your profile, click on **APPLY FOR A STUDENT LOAN**. Follow the instructions on how to have your ID verified. *See backside for more information.*

STEP 4: LOGIN AND APPLY!

Log in using your Mobile card app or the USB Card reader (provided to you from Service BC if using a desktop computer). Complete the application.

Setting up a Mobile Card

IS YOUR PHONE SECURE?

Your iPhone, iPad or Android must have device protection enabled to be able to add a card. For example, on an iPhone or iPad you must have a passcode or Touch ID to unlock your device.



INSTALL THE APP

Install the BC Services Card App. Open App and click ADD CARD Read and accept the BC Services Card Terms of Use. **It is recommended you allow the BC Services Card App to receive notifications.**

SCAN OR ENTER YOUR SERIAL NUMBER

Scan or enter your serial number on the back of your card. You will then be asked to confirm your birthday.



VERIFY THAT IT IS YOUR CARD

The Government has implemented a new verification process to enhance security and make the card more secure to help protect everyone's privacy.

There are three options to verify your identity:

- 1) **Video call**- a Service BC agent will confirm your identity during the call.
- 2) **Send a Video** - You will receive an email once they have reviewed your video and have confirmed your identity.
- 3) **In-person** at a Service BC Centre - See below for locations.



SERVICE BC OFFICES

It is recommended you contact the office to confirm their hours. You will also want to make sure you have the Services BC App downloaded prior to visiting the Service BC Office.

INFORMATION TO HAVE NEARBY WHEN COMPLETING YOUR STUDENT LOAN APPLICATION

- School code - Selkirk College is AJAP
- Program code and credential type (select from drop down)
- Start/end dates
- Year of the program you are in
- Course load
- Date you graduated high school
- Daycare or spousal support costs
- Dependent(s), spouse, parent information – if applicable
- Line 150 of your 2018 Income tax return as well as your spouse or parents if applicable
- Scholarships, bursaries, EI, Social Assistance, parent/relative contributions or any other income/contributions during your study period

Financial assistance may be available to eligible students - it is not guaranteed funds.
