Student Housing Expectations And License Agreement For Short-Term Guests

Welcome to Selkirk College and Student Housing! We hope you enjoy your stay. As guests, you are expected to abide by the following terms and conditions. Please read them over carefully.

- 1. You have been issued a wristband**, please wear it while you are visiting Kekuli House, as this will enable Student Housing staff to know you have been registered to be here after Quiet hours.
- You are expected to comply with requests from the Student Housing and College officials. Harassment and/or verbal abuse toward Student Housing staff and Advisors will not be tolerated. We have Quiet Hours, Sunday – Thursday 11:00pm-8:00am Friday/Saturday 1:00am-8:00am. Courtesy hours are 24 hours a day, so excessive noise, or rambunctious behaviour is not acceptable. Any conduct which is inappropriate or disruptive to the residence community or the College, will not be tolerated. If you feel the need to be rowdy and loud, you will be asked to find an alternate location.
- Responsible use of alcoholic beverages is only permitted in your assigned room subject to provincial laws. Anyone consuming alcohol must be nineteen (19) years of age or older. Alcohol consumption or the purveyance of open alcohol in any common area of Student Housing (including walkways, stairwells, lounges, foyers, parking lots, etc.) is strictly prohibited.
- Kekuli House is a drug free zone and should be adhered to. (this includes any drug paraphernalia as well)
- If you hear the Fire Alarm-you must leave the building. The Muster point is located at the East side of the building-by the Green Garbage dumpsters.
- The possession or use of any weapons, fireworks, or explosive devices in Student Housing is prohibited.
- 7. There is no smoking of any kind inside Student Housing;** common area or rooms. There are designated smoking areas located around the exterior of the building.

Guests who violate these rules will be asked to leave immediately. We appreciate your cooperation.

Selkirk College shall not be responsible for property belonging to the Guest which may be lost, stolen or damaged in any way, whether on, near or about the premises, including the storage facilities.

The Guest indemnifies and consents to save harmless the College from and against any claim or expense, loss or damage suffered by the guest or any other person by reason of any negligence by the Guest or by way of his/her breach or non-performance of conditions or the terms of this agreement by the Guest. Further, the Guest is aware that he/she has a responsibility to self-insure or to seek personal liability insurance coverage for responsibility that he/she may have for any injury to and/or death of a Guest, or invitee or others while in or about Student Housing.
