

The following are examples of frequently used forms of citation. For more explanation and further examples, see *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers* (in the library at REF LB 2369 G53).

Each time that you use an author's words or ideas in a paper, you must cite (i.e. credit) the source.

Citations in text are brief credits in the text of a paper. **Works Cited** is a complete list of all the sources cited, placed in alphabetical order at the end of a paper.

Your paper should be double-spaced throughout, including quotations and the list of works cited.
