

Field Assessment

The WIL Advisor or a program Instructor will contact you and your workplace to conduct an assessment of your work skills to create a skill map.

Education Plan

Your WIL advisor will combine all information the application with the skill map to determine which courses you need to take.

The advisor will clarify which competencies you have proven for specific course learning outcomes and which learning outcomes you



still need to submit through PLAR (Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition).




PLAR and Continued Education
