#### FINANCIAL AID FOR STUDENTS

Scholarships are awarded to students based on academic excellence. Apply between **February 15 and March 31.** 

Bursaries are awarded to students based on financial need. Apply between **September 15 and October 31.** 

Other financial aid options are available, including transfer scholarships and funding for Indigenous students.






